I. ROUTINE BUSINESS

The City Council of the City of Bridgeport, Nebraska, met in budget public hearing meeting at Prairie Winds Community Center, 428 Main Street, Bridgeport, Nebraska, on the 15th day of September 2021, beginning at 6:16 P.M.

Following the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America, Mayor Charlie Browne called the meeting to order. Roll call resulted as follows: Present: Will Deines, Mark Wickard, Dean Rahmig. Absent: Jason Floyd
